You have a decision to make. What are you going to do after your GCSE's?

- 6th Form College –focus on A levels or a combination of A levels and BTEC Level 3.
- College – vocational courses focused on developing practical skills or to focus on academic options such as A levels.
- Apprenticeships – to register for a level 2 or 3 apprenticeship go to: www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship

Key Points to consider

- What subjects am I good at? And what do I enjoy?
- What is my learning style? Is it academic (A Levels) or a more vocational / technical route (BTECs, T Levels)?
- Do I have the grades I need?
- Do I have a back-up plan?
- Am I going to university? What subjects do I need to access the course?
- What subjects do I need to study to get the job I want in the future?

Key Things to do

- Have a discussion with your careers advisor, Suzanne – in school every Wednesday and some Mondays/ Fridays.
- Have a discussion with your parent/carer.
- Attend virtual college open evenings.
- Investigate apprenticeships available in the Goole area.
