We are heavily oversubscribed for the third consecutive year, with numbers continuing to grow year on year.

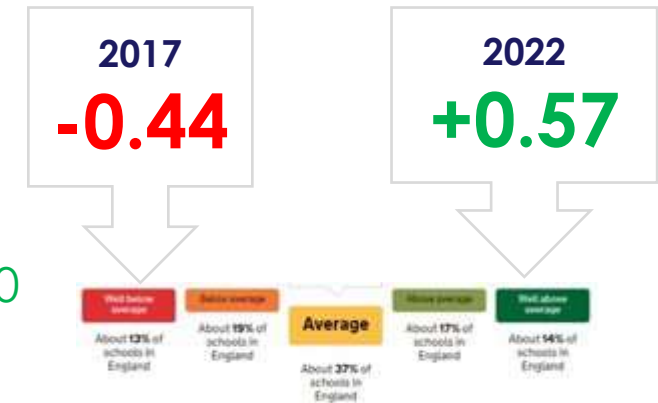
